

## Preparing for your Glaucoma Visit

Bring all your ocular medications (eye drops and ointments) in their original container in a clear bag.
Bring your prescription glasses, if applicable.
Bring your Ontario health card or other insurance coverage information.
Bring a list of all your medications.
Bring a pair of sunglasses.
Be aware of the name of your optometrist. If you do not have one, look up the nearest optometry clinic to your home.
Be aware of your pharmacy's address and phone number.
Take your regularly scheduled eye drops on the day of your appointment.
If you are scheduled for an in-office minor procedure, ensure you have an available driver.
Your appointment may take up to <u>3 hours</u> as you are seeing a specialist, we thank you for your patience.
Pay for parking by the entrance of the building door.
